

Current CGT Programs

Kids in Gardens Program

A youth (K-6th) garden education program in partnership with Homer Davis Elementary School (Flowing Wells School District). This district serves low-income communities.

Family Gardening Camp

Through a family-based camp program, provide parents, children, siblings and their relatives with the instruction and resources to become lifelong gardeners and stewards of our Sonoran Desert environment.

Food Resiliency Program

Programs funded by CGT that provide low-to-no cost gardening opportunities primarily for economically marginalized individuals and families, many who are refugees and immigrants.

Desert Gardening Program

Public gardening program at CGT's 20 sites; annual fees provide individual plots, irrigation water, tools, equipment, workshops, training, and general support.

Adopt A Garden Program

Business sponsorships that provide financial and operating support to select "adopted gardens."

Garden Stories Program

Program to collect, preserve and share gardeners' stories. Similar to NPR's StoryCorps, gives gardeners opportunity to share their gardening successes and failures, tips and suggestions, experiences and memories of special times spent in gardens.
